

# DLL Portal Security Enhancement FAQ

## 1 What is two-factor authentication?

Two-factor authentication is an electronic authentication method in which a user is granted access to a website or application only after successfully presenting two or more pieces of evidence to an authentication mechanism like a password & a unique code.

## 2 Why is DLL making this change?

Passwords can be difficult to manage, and they're easy to steal. Hackers have sophisticated ways of obtaining your passwords, but with two-factor authentication, your mobile device is required to complete a login. That reduces the risk of your accounts being compromised. Two-factor authentication is a best practice for all digitally based accounts!

## 3 I am having trouble locating your two-factor authentication activation email, what do I do?

- a. You can find the activation email by searching for the sender: [dllinformationsecurity@go.dllgroup.com](mailto:dllinformationsecurity@go.dllgroup.com) in your email inbox
- b. Still having trouble locating? Check your spam folder for the same email address above
- c. If you are unable to locate the email, please contact your DLL account manager

## 4 What is my username?

Your username is your email address

## 5 What if my activation link doesn't work?

If you are having issues accessing the link, contact your DLL account manager to have a new link sent directly to your email address

## 6 What if I am using other DLL portals and already have two-factor authentication set up?

If you are already using other DLL portals with two-factor authentication, your username and password will be the same.
